

Project 1000 has a range of Handwoven home decor and lifestyle articles like Floor Rugs, Cushions with fillers, Baskets, Totes, Slings, Place Mats, Bathroom Mats, Laptop jackets, Bread Baskets, etc. All products a 100% cotton and easy to maintain. They are designed and handwoven on traditional wooden looms by female rural artisans from Maharashtra (India). Quality and utility is of prime importance, thus all product development is done meticulously under the Gainful Employment Program conducted in Shanti Seva Nidhi Trust in the name of PROJECT 1000. The goal is community upliftment and women empowerment with an aim to achieve financial autonomy.

Our program is a twofold approach: the first month focuses on Training, Product Development and Quality Control. The next module is one month of perfecting and churning out a saleable product that can be marketed on an international level along with this we also train the women in soft skills to help them deal with customer queries. This approach helps us direct the immense under-utilised rural talent towards creative activity and bring to the forefront the charm of handwoven articles over their over-mechanised peers.

All our products are handwoven using upcycled textile waste. Inline with our belief in environmental protection, reuse-recycle and the use of 100% natural cotton thereby, creating a sustainable lifestyle and supporting the Indian cotton farmers. Our mission is to create gainful employment to help rural women take their respectful and rightful place in society.
